Social Distancing and Sanitation Policy

All guidelines that were constructed for this event were taken from government agencies, such as the CDC, the FDA and Oklahoma State guidelines for Phase 3 reopening.

In determination of best social distancing practices, SRN has made the decision to cancel children's activities and the seminars. This will limit close interactions between guests.

Vendor Registration:

Vendors will be checked in and out one at a time at two separate tables. Sanitizer will be used by volunteers when interacting directly with the public.

Survivor Resource Network will provide the following:

1. Food Vendor Guidelines & Best Practices - see attached
2. Booth (Non-Food Truck) Guidelines & Best Practices - see attached
3. Signs encouraging:
 - a. Limit the amount of time you spend in close contact with others.
 - b. Avoid touching surfaces in public places, when possible.
 - c. Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces regularly.
 - d. Clean your hands often, especially after touching surfaces in public places and before eating, and avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
 - e. Have one member of the household go to the food vendor to order for the whole family
 - f. Customers will be asked to minimize handling items unless they intend to purchase the items.
4. Vendors will be encouraged to provide their own cleaning supplies and sanitizing products. However, supplies for vendors will be kept on hand if needed to encourage implementation of the best practices - including but not limited to masking tape, gloves, face masks, and extra cleaning supplies. These will be provided by SRN gratis.
5. In addition to the Portable Toilets, SRN will increase the availability of hand sanitizer available for public use. The Portable Toilets are also equipped with hand sanitizer dispensers.
6. Vendor booths will be distanced from one another and moved back from walking paths to allow more room between those attending.
